ATTENTION – NEW APARTMENT COMPLEX PROPOSED – YOUR FEEDBACK IS REQUESTED!

WSE Development, a development arm of Worthing Company, proposes to assemble 16 parcels east of Commerce Drive along Weekes, Freeman and Columbia for the development of a 318 unit apartment complex. In order to effectuate the development with many of the features desired by the City of Decatur and the developer (features such as street improvements along Commerce, wide sidewalks, extension of the multi-use trail, extension of Freeman Street and cleanup of the existing deplorable conditions of two streams which traverse the property), stream buffer variances are needed.

WSE proposes to mitigate any negative impacts of stream buffer encroachment (although it sincerely believes there would be no negative impacts) by an aggressive stream bank restoration plan and a stepped up water quality treatment plan to treat any storm water traversing the site. WSE will present details of its plans and its variance requests at the meeting. The variance requests will then be heard by the Zoning Board of Appeals on June 25th at its next public meeting.

Friends of Shoal Creek – Caroline Grant

Friends of Shoal Creek (FoSC) is a new and enthusiastic coalition of neighbors based in Decatur, Georgia. FoSC formed in early 2019 to protect the natural and community resources of Shoal Creek, including the wildlife and habitat in the surrounding Shoal Creek watershed.
